A collision occurred at Schaw Sta-  
tion, at 2 o'clock Saturday morning  
on the C.P.R. between two freight  
trains, by which a locomotive and a  
number of cars with their contents  
were wrecked and afterwards consum-  
ed by fire. Conductor Sam Carson  
was thrown out of his caboose and  
narrowly escaped with his life, sus-  
taining injuries from which he will re-
