

Instructions for Concert Recordings

Download and Extract Concert Package

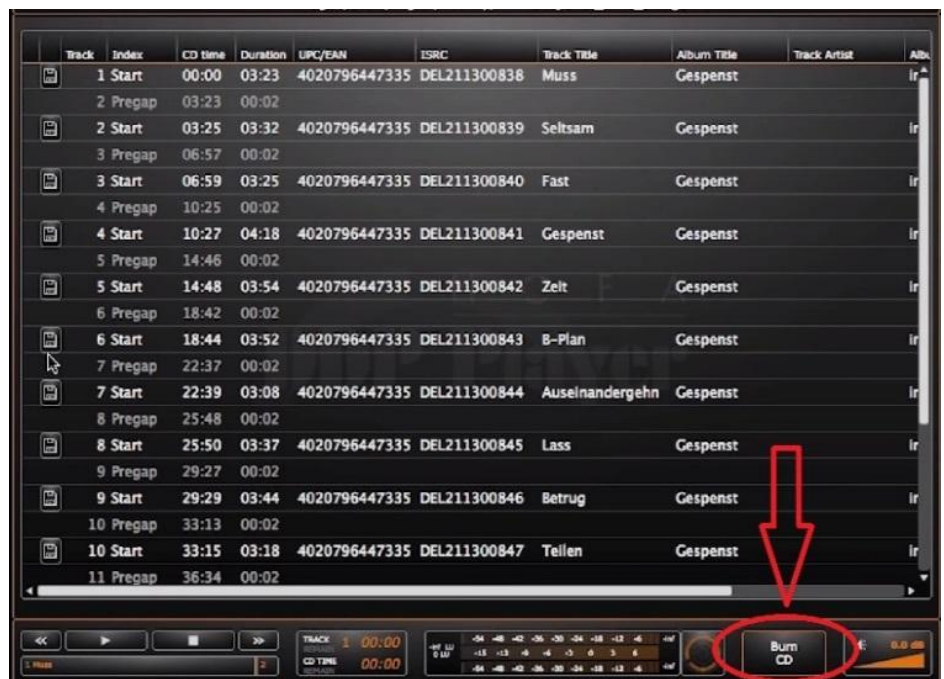
- Download the concert download package. It will be delivered in a compressed (zipped) folder
- Locate the downloaded folder (e.g., in the “downloads” folder in Windows), and extract it to wherever you want for safe keeping. To extract:
 - For PC users, right click and select “extract all”
 - For Mac users, double click
- In the extracted folder you will find:
 - A folder of mp3s
 - The CD master (you typically won’t need to touch this)
 - Two custom “CD makers” to burn the master to a CD using your home computer, one version for Windows computers and one for Macs

Notes on MP3s

- The mp3s folder contains a subfolder with the name and date of your concert. This folder contains the music files themselves and is ready to be added to your music library.
- Note that some tracks are mastered to flow from one into the next (e.g., two movements of the same piece). In this case you may hear an abrupt start or stop when listening as some music players will insert a brief pause between tracks.

To Burn CDs

- Double click either the “PC CD maker” or “Mac CD maker.”
- The player looks like the picture here. Using the controls on the bottom left you can listen to the master on your computer using play, stop, forward, and rewind buttons.
- At the bottom right is a button to burn the master to a CD. Click the button, put a blank CD in your CD drive and follow the instructions.
