NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

-  The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. Exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. You should obtain the Regulations for Agility Trials from AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, (919) 233-9767, info@akc.org, or www.akc.org. The exhibitor is responsible for entering their dog in the correct class. Check your entry form carefully and ensure you have entered correctly. Returned checks or incomplete or incorrect entries do not constitute valid entries.
-  Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial site at the discretion of the Event Committee. In such cases, HMKC will not refund any fees paid. The club and its agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, or to any of their dogs or property and assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the club or any official thereof.
-  Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
-  All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a PAL/ILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.
-  Move-ups after the closing date must be received (in writing or email) by the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 p.m. on Monday, October 4, 2021. Day-to-day move ups are allowed if notice is submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the end of the last class on Friday and Saturday. For allowable changes from Novice A to Novice B, see Ch. 1, Sec. 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent).
-  Crating space is tight in the building! Please keep your setup as compact as possible. The Event Committee may consolidate or move setups if necessary, to ensure crating space is available for all and access to the ring is maintained. The building will be available to all exhibitors to set up crates starting at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, October 8. DO NOT enter the building earlier than 8:00 a.m. Use of FLEXI-TYPE LEADS is NOT allowed in the building.
-  Vending is by reservation only. Indoor vending is on a first-received basis and is \$20.00 for the weekend. Outdoor vending is free. For vending reservations, please contact the TRIAL CHAIR.
-  **ENTRY CONFIRMATION:** If an e-mail address is provided, a preliminary confirmation will be sent soon after the entry is received and processed. Please REVIEW IT CAREFULLY and notify the Trial Secretary of any necessary changes as soon as possible. If no email is provided, confirmation of entry will be sent by USPS after closing. A FINAL CONFIRMATION and PRELIMINARY JUDGING SCHEDULE will be sent soon after closing. If you do not receive a confirmation and schedule at least 5 days prior to the trial, contact the Trial Secretary.
-  Dogs may arrive ringside any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary/permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to start of their class. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

OBSTACLES, RING, CLASS ORDER & PRIZES

Obstacles and jumps used in this trial shall meet the specifications contained in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials (available at www.akc.org). All classes will take place indoors on medium packed dirt in one 80' x 120' ring.

All exhibitors will be permitted to walk the course prior to the start of the class as per the judge's instructions. Course maps will be posted for photographing.

Please note: CLASS ORDER each day is subject to change, based on the number of entries received for each class.

SCHEDULE & CLASSES OFFERED

FRIDAY – judging begins at 9:00 a.m. Tall dogs to Small dogs.
Time 2 Beat, FAST*, Standard & JWW
Class order: Excellent/Master, Open, Novice

SATURDAY – judging begins at 8:00 a.m. Small dogs to Tall dogs.
Premier JWW, JWW, Time 2 Beat, Standard & FAST*
Class order: Excellent/Master, Open, Novice

SUNDAY – judging begins at 8:00 a.m. Tall dogs to Small dogs.
Premier Standard, Standard, & JWW
Class order: Excellent/Master, Open, Novice

***FAST Classes** will be nested and will have one walk through for all classes. All classes will be run together by jump height.

****Premier Class** Both Standard & JWW Premier courses are Master level courses incorporating elements that challenge both handler and dog in ways seen in international competitions. The Premier class has a single class level. Dogs Eligible to enter Novice, Open, Excellent, or Master level classes may enter the Premier Class. Refer to AKC regulations at <http://cdn.akc.org/Agility/Agility-Chapter11-PremierCass.pdf>.

FEO - FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the T2B and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used. Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On - Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Mixed Regular and Preferred Classes in Same Trial Weekend and Multiple Jump Heights on Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up their titles while also entered in Pref. Master STD/JWW to work towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

If a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versus) on the same trial day, no Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and JWW be either in both Regular or both Preferred on the same trial day.

A dog may be entered in multiple jump heights on the same trial day in Regular and Preferred classes. For example, the same dog may be entered in 20" Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C" Premier STD/JWW on the same day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or jump heights within the same trial weekend clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

PRIZES AND AWARDS (offered by HMKC)

Qualifiers: flat ribbons

1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th places: flat ribbons

Titles: rosettes

MACH, PACH & PAX titles earned at the trial will receive a bar and premium rosette.

***Please let the Trial Secretary know if you and your dog are close to earning a MACH, PACH or PAX so we are prepared to CELEBRATE with you!**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (COVID-19)

ONLINE ENTRIES: Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Service home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be as follows: **100 runs/day via online entries; 250 runs/day via paper entries**. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

REFUND POLICY: 100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if a written (or email) request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date and time. After closing, full refunds will be given for bitches in season if written (or email) notification is received by the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial. Verification from a veterinarian may be required at the club's discretion. **Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. **No entry fee will be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, COVID-19 State or county requirements, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. **Bitches in season are not allowed on the Trial grounds.**

Catalogs: \$10.00. Please pre-order catalogs on the entry form. No catalogs will be available at the trial.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

The following jump heights shall be used in all agility trial classes:

Regular classes	Preferred classes
8 inches..... for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	4 inches
12 inches..... for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	8 inches
16 inches..... for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	12 inches
20 inches..... for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	16 inches
24 inches..... for dogs over 22 inches at the withers	20 inches
24" Choice... Only dogs 22" and under may be entered in this height at owner's discretion.	

When filling out the entry form, please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **You are responsible for entering your dog in the correct jump height.** Dogs without a valid jump height card/form may still compete, but they must be measured/wicketed by the judge of record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only.

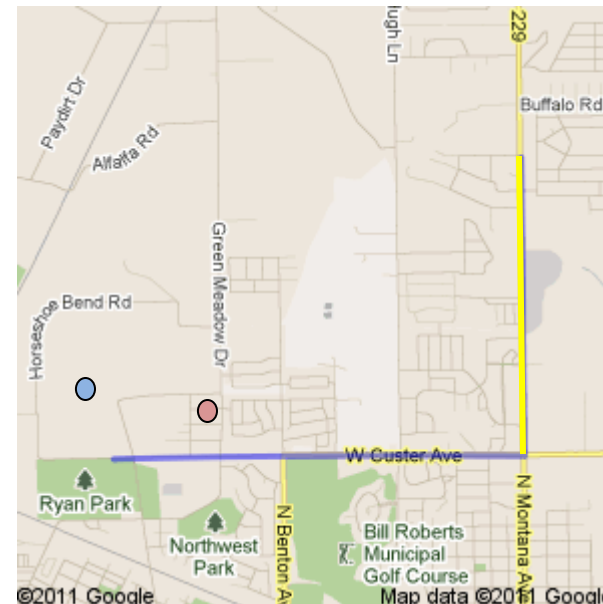
DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From Hwy 12 (from Elliston/Missoula/Spokane) Hwy 12 West turns into Euclid Avenue as you enter the west end of Helena. At the Henderson Street light, turn LEFT and proceed north on Henderson. Just past the railroad underpass the L&C County Fairground will be straight ahead of you, at the corner of Henderson St. and Custer Avenue. **ATTN: This is a LOW UNDERPASS. For vehicles over 12 feet in height, please follow this alternate route:** At the intersection of Joslyn and Euclid (one light west of Henderson), turn LEFT. After a few blocks, the road will curve to the left, **BU** continue STRAIGHT. Follow this road over the RR tracks. Follow road as it curves right. At the stop sign (Henderson), turn LEFT to the Fairgrounds and proceed as above.

From Hwy 12/Hwy 287 (from Townsend/Bozeman) Follow Highway 12 East into Helena. Just past Wal-Mart, stay in right lane and turn RIGHT to proceed NORTH on I-15 to Exit 194 (Custer Avenue). At the end of the ramp, turn LEFT onto Custer Ave. Proceed STRAIGHT on Custer Ave approx. 2.4 miles. At the intersection of Custer Ave and Henderson St, turn RIGHT into L&C County Fairgrounds.

From I-15 South (from Butte/Boulder) Take Exit 194 (Custer Ave). At the end of the ramp, turn LEFT onto Custer Ave. Proceed STRAIGHT on Custer Ave approx. 2.4 miles. At the intersection of Custer Ave and Henderson St, turn RIGHT into L&C County Fairgrounds.

From I-15 North (from Great Falls) Take Exit 194 (Custer Ave). At the top of the ramp, turn RIGHT on Custer Ave. Proceed STRAIGHT on Custer Ave approx. 2.4 miles. At the intersection of Custer Ave and Henderson St, turn RIGHT into L&C County Fairgrounds.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
