CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

For the well being of our Patrons & Staff we ask you to consider our modified conditions of entry. Any breaches of these conditions may result in you being asked to leave and or refused entry of the venue.

- Members must provide membership card and guests must provide photo identification to enter. All patron must scan the Service NSW QR code or complete the web form for contact tracing purposes. Minors (under 18) details will be recorded under a parent of guardian's contact details via Service NSW system. We also ask that you sign out upon leaving the Club if you signed in via your phone.
- If you are unwell or showing the mildest of respiratory symptoms (such as cough, sore/scratchy throat, or shortness of breath) or unexplained fever, please do not enter the Club.
- If you have visited or returned from any declared Covid19 hotspot in the past 14 days, you will not be permitted entry.
- Individuals who live in or have visited any areas with active Covid19 cases in the last 14 days, you will not be permitted entry.
- Practice good personal hygiene.
- The Club is limited to a capacity of 475. Staff may ask you to move from one space to another if a specific area is overcrowded.
- We will support 1.5m physical distancing by limiting the capacity of the venue accordance with the density limit in the Public Health Order of one person per two square meters.

Entry via main door on Dalley Street only, should you require assisted entry please see reception staff to arrange access via ramp on northern side of Club or ring the doorbell on the gate at the top of the ramp for staff assistance.
