







<p>1. Form first loop...</p>  <p>Hold here</p>	<p>2. Bring tail under and up...</p>  <p>Hold here</p>
<p>3. Bring tail over and down through second loop...</p>  <p>Hold here</p>	<p>4. Hold loop and pull tail to tighten...</p>  <p>Hold here</p>
<p>5. Feed tail through loop and pull both ends firmly to tighten knot.</p>  <p>Hold here</p>	<p>6. Cut excess tail and add bead to string if desired.</p> 
<p>Use this knot to secure ukulele string ends when instruments have bridges designed to have the strings secured under the bridge plate inside the ukulele body.</p>
