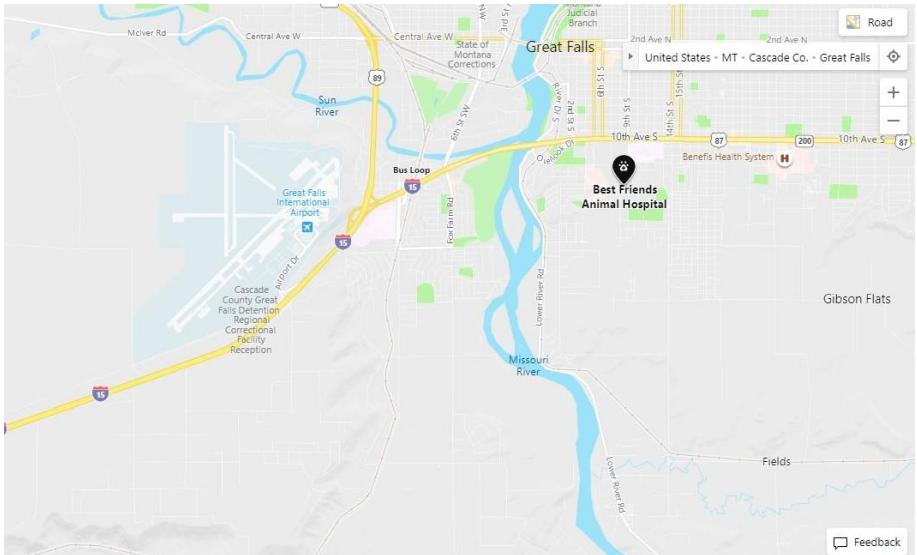

**Directions from Interstate 15 North**, take Exit 280 (Central Ave West). Travel east to 6<sup>th</sup> St SW. Turn left at light, heading north approx. ½ mile. Turn right at Dog Show Entrance into MT EXPO PARK west gate.

**Directions from Interstate 15 South**, take Exit 280 (Central Ave West). Travel east to 6<sup>th</sup> St SW. Turn left at light, heading north approx. ½ mile. Turn right at Dog Show Entrance into MT EXPO PARK west gate.

### **FASTCats:**

The purpose of the AKC FASTCat event is to provide all dogs and their owners an enjoyable, healthy activity in which they can participate. Dogs run singularly. The dogs time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. Titles are awarded when a dog has accumulated a given number of points.

### **Timing:**

2 Stop Watches will be used.

### **Inspection:**

All dogs will be inspected for soundness and measured, if needed, prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in season prior to running each event. Any entry found during inspection to be unfit to compete, lame, or bitches in season shall be barred from competition and entry fees shall be refunded.

### **Course:**

The Start - Dog may start up to 10 feet behind the starting line. Finish - It is required this be a minimum of 30 yards.

### **Earning Points:**

A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers.

18" or greater = handicap is 1.0

12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5

Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

Points – mph multiplied by the dog's handicap.

### **Covid Rules:**

Exhibitors, judges, volunteers and spectators will be required to comply with all Facility, Local and State mandates in place at the time of the event. BE PREPARED TO WEAR A MASK IN THE RING IF YOUR JUDGE HAS REQUESTED THAT EXHIBITORS BE MASKED.

**NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS**  
**EXHIBITORS MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR SOMEONE TO CATCH**  
**THEIR DOG AT THE END OF THE RUN**  
**NO RERUNS UNLESS EQUIPMENT FAILURE**

1. Coursing Ability & Fast CAT tests are open to all dogs 12 months of age or older that are individually registered with AKC, recognized foreign registries or have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS). Open to all sighthounds as well as those with breed disqualifications.
2. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signature, and the Agreement found on the Official AKC Entry Form in this premium.
3. REFUNDS: Bitches in season and lame dogs will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry less the AKC recording fee. Refunds or other absences or withdrawals made after the event entry closing date will not be made.
4. Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a do's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded less the AKC recording fee.
5. Racing muzzles are allowed. No pinch collars and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed.
6. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, and communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
7. The HUNTMASTER is responsible for field safety and therefore s/he is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, s/he has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
8. Any decisions made by the Event officials regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the Event officials to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The Event officials are responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.
9. Entry fees will not be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives,
10. Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC or ECKC trial volunteers or any dog(s) or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
11. There will be a minimum of \$25 returned check charge.
12. ECKC reserves the right to alter the course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the test. The entire course and run-out area will be fenced. Areas outside of the course are not fenced. Exhibitors must contain and control their dogs at all times.
13. Children MUST be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.
14. Any dog that eliminates on the course or in the run-out area will receive a non-qualifying (NQ) score.
15. Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, and Handler of the dog running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.
16. The Club, ECKC, its agents, members, representatives, and volunteers assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event. By entering this event, you agree to this provision.
17. **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. **There will be an outside designated area where dogs are allowed to relieve themselves.** Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.
