

# Waggoner Native Releases Her Debut Worship Album

Amy (Matthews) Lloyd, a Christian singer and recording artist based near Washington, DC, has released her debut worship album "All I Need," a collection of modern and traditional hymns

and praise songs that turns the heart's attention to the soul's greatest need.

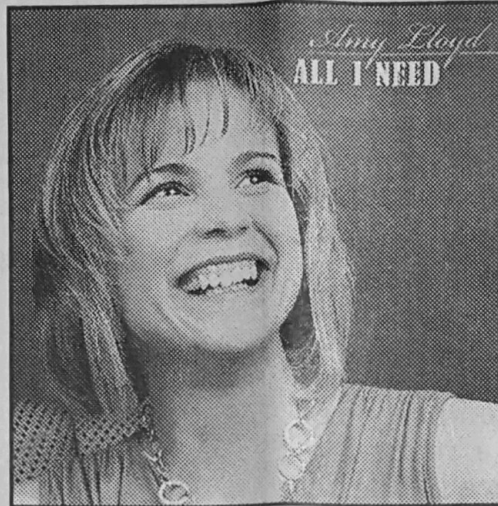
Lloyd, a graduate of Lincolnwood High School, is the daughter of Rodney and Beverly Matthews of Springfield, formerly of Waggoner.

The album has a folk-inspired, acoustic sound that weaves together themes of God's grace and love. From popular lyrics in the opening track, "Grace Flows Down," to the profound songwriting of "Holy Spirit," to the familiar words of "Enough," Amy's pure vocals will engage listeners and command their attention throughout.

"The songs on this album continue to have a deep impact on me and my relationship with the Lord," said Lloyd. "Whether someone is rejoicing or suffering, I pray listeners will find that the words and music draw them closer to the Savior.

Other songs on the album include "My Redeemer's Love," "Me For You," "Before the Throne of God Above," "O the Deep, Deep Love of Jesus," "Here is Your God (No One Else)," "Rescue," "When Trials Come" and a bonus track, "Fullness of Grace."

"The album's name, 'All I Need,' comes from the first song I selected, 'My Redeemer's Love,'" said Lloyd. "In the chorus of the



song, it is written, 'Your love is all I need.' As I meditated on those lyrics, I reaffirmed to God that He supplies all my needs through His merciful grace and love. The theme of this album was born from those words."

Lloyd's musical influences include modern hymn writers Keith and Kristyn Getty as well as the sounds and songwriters of Sovereign Grace Music. "All I Need" also includes two original songs penned by friend and pastor, Mike Foster, of Ridgewood Bible Church in Lockport, NY.

As for origins of the album, Lloyd says she spent a month journaling a list of songs to possibly present as a concert. "God had other plans. When my voice teacher tossed out the idea of recording an album, I knew what that list was for; the album tracks had already been chosen."

For several years Lloyd and her husband, Matt, have been involved in missions work in Russia. Since November is National Adoption Awareness Month, Lloyd will be giving a portion of the sales of the album through Dec. 31 to Doorways to Hope, a mission to help orphans find loving, Christian families in their home countries.
