We have a total number of 64 members (30 regular, 28 associate, 3 junior and 3 honorary). A quorum is 6 members. We have 23 members in breeder referral and have 48 households represented in membership. The trophy fund is <\$946.62>, so we are in need of a concentrated effort to resolve that deficit.
