Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Veterans Class: for Champion Dogs & Bitches 7 years of age and older on the day of the show.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 "Rules Applying To Dog Shows" provide that a neutered male or a spayed bitch may be entered as a veteran.

*Chapter 3, Section 13" A dog that has been defeated in any regular class or non-regular class for single dog entries is ineligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Award of Merit

The Award of Merit is a Rosette given by the judge to recognize outstanding champions excluding those selected for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch. Champions are the only recipients of these awards. Up to 20% of eligible dogs competing for Best of Breed may be presented with the award. The presentation of the Awards of Merit will follow the judging of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, and Best of Winners.

Sweepstakes

The Scottish Terrier Club of Michigan Sweepstakes will be open to all Scottish Terriers between the ages of 6 months and under 18 months. Professional handlers may show only the dogs owned or co-owned by them in Sweepstakes. Puppies shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at the regular class fee on the regular entry form, shown as "Additional Class".

Classes

The Following Classes Are Offered For Dogs & Bitches

JUNIOR	6 months and under 9 months
SENIOR	9 months and under 12 months
ADULT	12 months and under 18 months

Sweepstakes Entry Money will be divided as follows:

50% for Classes 50% for Division Run-Off

50% Class monies shall be divided by class as follows:

First- 50% Second-25% Third-15% Fourth-10%

The First & Second Place Dogs and Bitches will compete for Division Run-Off Stakes.

50% Division Run-Off monies shall be divided by Age Division as follows:

First-50% Second-25% Third-15% Fourth-10%

Challenge Trophies

These Challenge and Memorial Trophies have the following rules. The Trophy may be retired by identical owners of the winning Scottish Terrier at the Annual Specialty Show, having won it three times, not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive years. The Trophy will remain in the possession of the Scottish Terrier Club of Michigan, Inc. until retired. Challenge Trophies may or may not be displayed at the show. A representative trophy will be given to commemorate win until permanent possession is awarded.

4 & Under 6 Months Beginner Puppy Competition
Entry Fee: \$10.00 per puppy

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for puppies that are at least four (4) months of age but less than six (6) months of age on the date of the competition. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin. Best of Breed and Best of Opposite to Best of Breed will be chosen. An AKC registration number or AKC Litter number is required for entry.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including Rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian’s protocol on order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in **Rules Applying to Dog Shows** will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications or faults such as color, height, weight, or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

To find out about any AKC event cancellations, call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
