**Tailgating:** You will have access to the tailgating area at 8:30 am. All tents must be in place by 10:30 am as the area will be closed to car traffic after 10:30. The tailgating area is the Gardens of Kennesaw Parking area. Vehicle parking will be available immediately across the street, or plan to Uber if required. Please plan to secure your tent with SAND BAGS and travel to and from the event safely.

**Tailgating:** You may bring whatever you like for tailgating with one exception (**NO GRILLS and NO FIRE**) **Any coolers are only allowed in the tailgate area and not allowed in the venue area.**

The Scott Family, David, Beth, Taylor and Mary Beth have been blessed with opportunity, love, and support from our family, friends, and the community. We have also experienced tragedy. In 2017, our eldest daughter Taylor, age 24, was diagnosed with stage 4 Cancer (Metastatic Adenocarcinoma). As you might imagine, our family experienced denial, fear, hope, and pain, and in late 2019, we lost Taylor after a long fought battle. This story is about what we learned and how we grew emotionally and spirituality through this experience. As Taylor battled cancer, we witnessed her strength and determination as well as her unending courage, compassion, and faith in God. Taylor focused on helping others by providing emotional support and fundraising and her efforts were inspirational to our family and others. We were not only inspired by what Taylor was doing, but also by the doctors and nurses who commit their lives helping people through this journey every day. We gained a heightened sense of empathy for our community as we entered the cancer world, which impacts most all of us at some point in one way or another. We became researchers and networkers in an effort to defy the odds of a terminal diagnosis. We would be remiss if I didn't mention our dogs, Norman, Winnie, Sophie and Blue who were always there for Taylor and our family and still offer us support every day. Taylor is a bright light who will continue to shine in our lives and through the ongoing work of the Taylor Ann Scott Foundation whose works are inspired by her compassion for all.
