

Barn Rules

Drive Slowly (and watch for dogs).

All riders and guests must sign a liability release before handling or riding any horse.

ALL riders and guests must fill out and sign a release. These should be downloaded from our website, printed, signed and brought to the barn before your first lesson.

Persons under 18 may not ride unsupervised without trainer's and parents permission.

Students need to purchase their own helmets, breeches, paddock boots, and half chaps. No riding in jeans.

Certified helmets with chin harness in place must be worn at all times while mounted.

Tie only in crossties, or inside stalls.

Check and double check that all gates and stall doors are properly latched.

Parents can drop children off for lessons. No more than two hours without prior arrangement.

Please give 24 hours notice to cancel or reschedule a lesson.

Jumping is allowed only during lessons.

Each person is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horses.

Clean up manure immediately. Do not wait until after you ride.

Do not feed any horse but your own without permission.

Do not allow your horse to "sniff noses" with other horses, as this can lead to injuries.

Horses must be led with a halter and lead rope. No ground tying.

Park in gravel areas only.

Each person will implement any additional instructions for safety made by our staff.

If you open it, close it! Gates, stall doors, feed bins, tack trunks... you get the idea.

If you borrow it, return it...cleaner than when you got it!

If you break it... fess up and tell me... it's not the end of the world, but I need to know.

If it meows or barks... **Pet it!**

If you ride it... **Love it!**

If you have any questions about **ANYTHING**, just ask. That's what we are here for!
