- * He cites Bob Dylan as a major influence on his work.
- * Since returning to Texas in 2007, McGee has toured regularly, playing venues, events, showcases and festivals including the 2017 Island Hopper Songwriter Festival in Fort Myers Beach, Florida. He’s slated to return in September for the 2019 festival.
- * McGee will celebrate the release of *El Camino Real* with a Feb. 21 performance at the Saxon Pub and a March 3 show at Gruene Hall.
