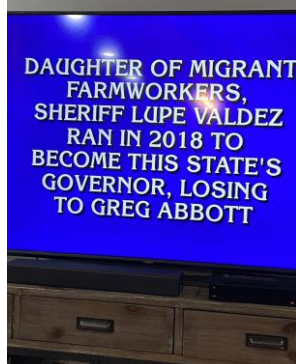


The Marshan Chronicles

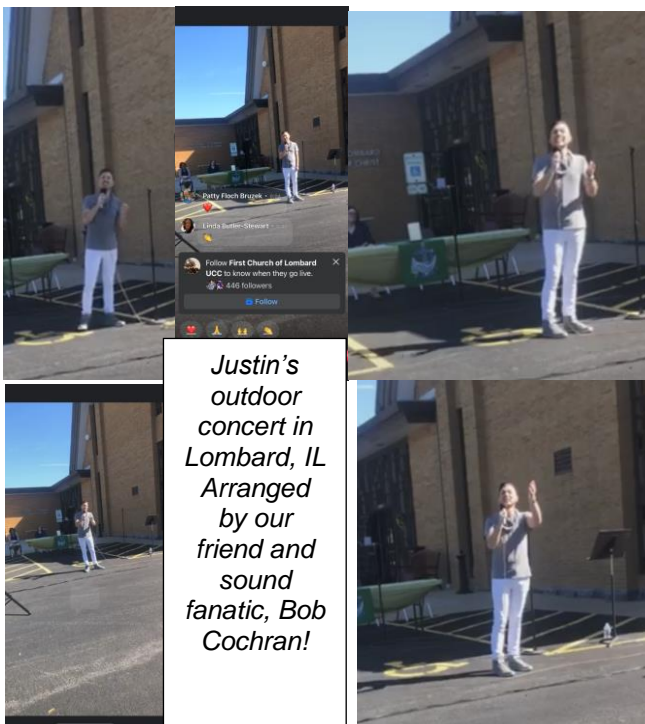
