Happy Thanksgiving! Wow, so much to be grateful for making it through these last two years – and so many to mourn whom we have lost.

I have often attended The Reformation Project (TRP) conferences, but I was not sure I would go this year. I didn't want to be part of a super spreader event!! But the more information I received, the more confident I became about going. They asked for your vaccination cards when you registered. They announced that they were holding all events in the very large conference room at the hotel – no small groups or small rooms. Everyone agreed to wear masks at all times when inside. Seating even in the grand “ballroom” was distanced by large round tables. So I had an antibody test to be absolutely sure the vaccines worked on me (with my immunosuppressants), and they did, and I decided to go.

What an incredible blessing. So many people with so many fascinating stories, insights and conundrums. Do you remember Eugene Peterson who wrote The Message version of the Bible? Eugene passed away in 2018 at age 85. His son, Eric Peterson, spoke at this conference and talked about his father's agony in dealing with LGBTQ inclusion in the church. Some of you will remember that a reporter, in Eugene Peterson's final interview of his life, asked him if he would perform a same sex wedding at his church if asked to do so. Peterson answered, “yes,” and brought the wrath of many evangelicals, as well as the wrath of his publishing company, down on his head. Try to picture that he is 84 years old and his whole legacy, as he sees it, is in The Message paraphrase that was his life's work. With that one word, “yes,” many of his readers threw out his books (and told him so), his publishing company (Lifeway) threatened to pull The Message off bookstore shelves and take it and all his

other books out of print, and his granddaughter came out.

His son, Eric, felt terrible that his Dad was forced to retract his statement the next day or face what felt like ruin at the very end of his life. Even at the time, I knew I could imagine what Eugene was going through. There were moments shortly after I came out that I would have tried to take it all back. I got to live long enough to work through that. He did not.

Another presenter was Jen Hatmaker, an evangelical women's leader who lost supporters and faced death threats when, after much prayer and Bible study, she came out in favor of gay marriage.

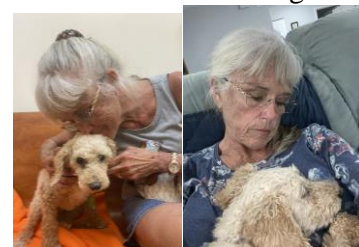
